- Reliability Good attendance and punctuality
- Presentation Wearing full school uniform (shirt tucked in, tie etc.).
- Good conduct No recent behaviour issues at any time during the school day, with consistently positive and co-operative conduct in all lessons
- Respect Positively acknowledging the authority of the school at all levels
- Organisation Coursework and homework being completed within the set timescales
- Ambition/Aspiration grades in your progress reports are good or outstanding

#### Commitment

In addition to the above, you will be committed to:

- Attend regular meetings
- Support the school during and beyond the normal school hours
- Attend Parent/Community Events
- Duties around school

- Be a good ambassador for the school and for your Year
- Correctly wear full school uniform
