Prior to completing the form please ensure you have read the Transition booklet which contains relevant information you or your child may need to help with their transition from primary to secondary school. Please allow approximately 30 minutes to complete the form and ensure you have the following information available prior to completion.

- Up to 3 emergency contacts, including name, address, home phone number, work phone number, mobile telephone number, email addresses.
- 3 pupils' names who your child would like to be in a form with (only one friend is guaranteed)
- GP's full contact details and any medical information
