The subjects you will be choosing now are the <u>foundation subjects</u> for your option choices in Year 10/11.




TIMELY CHOICES



Prioritise your future

What do I need to be a ...?

To get into...... you usually need Degree (or equivalent), A-levels (or equivalent), <u>along with five</u> <u>GCSEs (grades 9-4),</u> including English language, maths and at least one science.

CONSTRUCTION

Employers will look for a good standard of education that often includes GCSE in (grades 9-4) in English and Maths. Previous experience in construction and design and technology is advisable.

POLICE OFFICER

2 or more GCSEs at grades 9 to 3 for a Level2 training course such as Public Services.4 or 5 GCSEs at grades 9 to 4 for a Level 3 training course.

• ENGINEER 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including Maths, Science and English Language

FORENSIC SCIENTIST

5 GCSEs at grade 9 to 4 including Maths, Science and English. This is in addition to 3 A-Level qualifications.


• NURSERY WORKER

Good level of Maths and Literacy. This may need evidencing through GCSE qualifications. Childcare qualification through an NVQ or BTEC


