Re: Summer Uniform Changes

Dear Parent/Carers

As we transition into the warmer months, we would like to inform you of some updates regarding the school uniform policy for the summer. Our aim is to ensure that students remain comfortable while maintaining the standards of professionalism and identity that our school community values.

Starting from Monday 3rd June and for the remainder of the school year, the following changes will be implemented:

Jumper: The school jumper / cardigan becomes optional.

Shorts/Skirts: Students can either wear school trousers, school skirt or school shorts. Skirts and shorts must be knee-length. Skirts must not be the lycra 'tube' type and must be worn with black tights or black socks. Shorts must be tailored and worn with black socks. PE shorts are not allowed to be worn outside of PE lessons.

Shirt: The regular button-up white shirt must be worn.

Tie: The regular clip-on school tie must be worn.

Footwear: As with the regular uniform, students are required to wear plain black leather shoes or plain black leather trainers. Sandals, flip-flops, crocs, sliders and open-toe shoes are not permitted for safety reasons.

Given the increased exposure to sunlight during the summer months, we strongly recommend that students wear sunscreen.

As a reminder, from September, tailored black shorts will become part of the main school uniform. On the next pages you will find some visual information on our summer uniform and what constitutes acceptable shorts and skirts. 

- (Optional) Black cardigan with lilac piping and TA/WPT logos
- TA clip-on tie
- White button-up shirt
- Plain black tailored trousers, or
- Plain black skirt*, or
- Plain black tailored shorts*
- Plain black leather shoes or plain black leather trainers
 - *Skirts and shorts must be knee-length
 - *Skirts must not be the lycra 'tube' type and must be worn with black socks or tights
 - *Shorts must be worn with black socks

- Colours other than black

- Pencil style (if skin tight)
- Tight fitting
